WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act of 1974 (Government Code sections 81000, et seq.) requires every state or local government agency to adopt and promulgate a Conflict of Interest Code or Policy; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") adopted a Conflict of Interest Policy for the Amador Fire Protection District (the "District") and

WHEREAS, the District's Conflict of Interest Policy includes a list of positions that are subject to mandatory disclosure of financial information, entitled "APPENDIX II – Amador Fire Protection District Designated Employees and Disclosure Categories"; and

WHEREAS, the District periodically reevaluates and amends its Conflict of Interest Code to conform to updates in the law and to ensure the list of positions is current; and

WHEREAS, the District has concluded that it is necessary to amend and readopt its Conflict of Interest Code, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed revisions to the conflict code of the District has been given as required.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY

The Political Reform Act (Government Code §81000 *et seq.*) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a standard conflict of interest code, contained in 2 California Code of Regulations §18730, that can be incorporated by reference in an agency's code. The Fair Political Practices Commission, after public notice and hearing, may amend section 18730 to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act.

The terms of 2 California Code of Regulations section 18730, incorporated herein by reference, and any amendments to that regulation duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices, together with the attached Appendices I and II, in which officials and employees (together referred to as "designated employees") are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, constitute the Conflict of Interest Code for the District.

Employees holding designated positions shall file their statements of economic interest with the District. All statements will be retained by the District and will be made available for public inspection and reproduction. (Government Code section 81008). The positions listed in Appendix II are the designated employees and are required to file statements at such times required by regulation, 2 California Code of Regulations section 18730, which includes upon appointment, annually, and upon termination.

The disclosure categories set forth in Appendix I specify which kinds of economic interests shall be reported. All designated employees shall disclose those economic interests described in the disclosure category to which they are assigned. It has been determined that the economic interests set forth in each designated position are the kinds of economic interests which it is foreseeable the employees could materially affect through their conduct of their departments.

The District's Administrative Officer, or their designee, shall provide the proper forms to designated employees of the District. All designated employees shall file statements of economic interest with the County Elections Official, or his or her designee.

APPENDIX I

AMADOR FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT Conflict of Interest Code Disclosure Category Definitions

<u>DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES</u> (Adopted in accordance with Government Code sections 87300, *et seq.*, and California Code of Regulations Title 2, sections 18730, *et seq.*)

Category 1:

All sources of income, interests in real property, and investments and financial interests in business entities located or doing business in Amador County.

Category 2:

All sources of income, and investments and financial interests in business entities located or doing business in Amador County.

Category 3: Employees with broad and general purchasing or contracting duties.

Investments in, sources of income from, and financial interests in business entities located or doing business in Amador County which are of the type the County would contract with for services, supplies, books, machinery, or equipment.

<u>Category 4</u>: Employees who contract or purchase on behalf of their department for a limited type of goods.

Investments in, sources of income from, and financial interests in business entities located or doing business in Amador County that are of the type the designated employee's department would contract with for services, supplies, books, machinery, or equipment.

Category 5:

Investments in, sources of income from, and financial interests in business entities located or doing business in Amador County that provide agricultural business-related services, supplies, materials, machinery, or equipment; and interests in agricultural real property located within the County.

Category 6:

Investments in, sources of income from, and financial interests in business entities located or doing business in Amador County which provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment of the type utilized by or doing business with or at the County Airport; interests in services provided by or property leased from the airport; and real property located adjacent to or that may be materially affected by its proximity to airport facilities.

Category 7:

Investments in, sources of income from, and financial interests in business entities located or doing business in Amador County that provide solid waste disposal or recycling services, supplies, materials, machinery, or equipment; and interests in real property that may be materially affected by its proximity to any County transfer station located within the County.

Category 8:

Investments in, sources of income from, and financial interests in business entities located or doing business in Amador County that provide goods or services related to health and human services, and all interests in real property in which any such services are provided or which may be materially affected by decisions made by the designated employee, or his or her department, or a governing counsel.

* All disclosure required by the category, unless disclosure is limited to specific subject areas.

Definitions

Applicable Income: The designated employee's gross income (including loans) and the employee's community property interest in his or her spouse's gross income aggregating \$500 or more received from any source located in or doing business in the jurisdiction. (loans reported on a separate schedule)

Applicable Investments and Financial Interests: Investments held by the designated employee, spouse and dependant children with an aggregate value of \$2,000 or more located or doing business in the jurisdiction. Includes investments held by a business entity or trust in which the designated employee, spouse and dependent children have an aggregate interest of 10% or greater.

Applicable Interest in Real Property: Interests located in the jurisdiction in which the employee, spouse, or dependent children have direct, indirect, or beneficial interest aggregating \$2,000 or more any time during the reporting period. The employee is not required to report a residence used exclusively as a personal residence.

Applicable Business Positions: Positions in which the designated employee is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or has held a position of management during the period covered by the report even if the employee received no income from the entity during the reported period.

Applicable Gift: Anything of value for which the designated employee has not provided equal or greater consideration to the donor. A gift is reportable if its fair market value is \$390 or more. In addition, multiple gifts aggregating \$390 or more received during the reporting period from a single source must be reported. Unless otherwise limited in the Disclosure Categories, gifts are reportable regardless of where the donor is located.

MOTION: It was moved by Director Crew and seconded by Director Forster and carried 4-0-1, to approve the agenda, Director Oneto absent.

PUBLIC MATTERS NOT ON THE AGENDA:

Cindy Grandbois, a member of the public addressed the Board by asking if the Firefighter turnover has slowed down. Chief Withrow responded with yes.

ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

<u>Presentation of Certificate of Recognition</u>: Presentation ensued relative to subject matter. Chair Brown presented the certificate of recognition to Cal Tran's employees Paul Brager and Mike Quinones for their quick response to calling 911 and assisting as needed to an incident that occurred August 23, 2023.

Fire Chief Update:

<u>Amador County Fire Chief's Meeting</u>: Discussion ensued relative to subject matter, specifically dispatching which includes two parts with Cal Fire, the first being the response plan and the response area (jurisdictional). What the current pattern has been is that Cal Fire is replacing local resources when it should be "in addition to". Also, during that meeting, everyone agreed that during code 2 calls, Cal Fire would not respond.

Personnel: Chief updated the Board of an incident that warrants recognition, he stated how proud he was of the first arriving engine and the other crews; specifically Engineer Toft, Captain Gonsalves, Firefighter Montesanti, and Firefighter Merlin for their outstanding performance, there was water flowing within two minutes of arriving on scene.
