ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

FY 2023-2024 New Benefit Assessment

Review and approve Preliminary Engineers Report: FM Chew introduced SCI Consultants, John Bliss and Chris Coulter who presented the report.

Director Oneto took his seat at 10:35 AM

Discussion ensued relative to subject matter. Chris stated that the base family dwelling assessment average rate is sixty five dollars. All property usage types are assessed by fire severity zones and time travel factor, properties near a fire station. John Bliss (JB) stated that they chose to do a parcel by parcel analyzation for a benefit assessment like this. The property range that is in use, size and possible development over time, we found that an acreage rate is more beneficial than a square footage rate. Proposition 218 requires a 45 day ballot, to give

voters time to evaluate property and also allows plenty of time for property owners to ask questions and/or have the engineers make correction if needed.

<u>MOTION</u>: It was moved by Director Forster and seconded by Director Axe however Director Oneto asked to continue the discussion. Motion died.

Director Oneto stated that he wanted the assessment to be based on square footage and not by the new calculations. Cindy Grandbois, a member of the public, asked if a parcel is an acre and what is the difference between the types of property and parcel size, what if the property is only a tenth of an acre? How does the owner calculate the new costs? JB addressed the questions by stating that each property owner will receive a ballot that will have their specific replacement assessment rate down to the penny along with a "voters guide" with how the assessment was calculated along with phone numbers to call for any questions. The voter can call the District or SCI. The minimum calculation is one acre, not a tenth. Cindy also asked how much would the annual maintenance cost be from SCI to calculate the benefit assessment for the District if they decide to use them? JB answered \$5,000-\$15,000.

Direction given to SCI by the BOD to calculate revenue and determine the increase difference between the new assessment and current, update the Engineers Report to reflect a detailed Table 1 Proposed Base Assessment Rates with comparison table of current assessment and Update the Engineers Report to define the difference between Range Land/Open Space and Agriculture. Confirm per acre or parcel.

Resolution 2a Adopting Proposition 218 Assessment Ballot Proceedings Procedures: SCI Consultants presented. Discussion ensued relative to subject matter.
